Correction

Due to an error in editing, the wrong draft of Nancy Brydges' review of the CD, Songs and Sonnets, with soprano Jane Leibel and pianist Kristina Szutor, was published in the August 2006 issue of CAML Review. As a result, it was not clear that Szutor was the pianist both for Arnold Schoenberg's Brettl-Lieder and Clifford Crawley's Grey Island, along with the other accompanying musicians noted in the review. Further, the text of Crawley's piece that was quoted in the review was taken from the conclusion of the fourth selection, not the end of the work. Finally, the description of Brettl-Lieder should have read, "They are entertainment pieces suitable for the popular literary cabarets of the time."
