Ed Hysen died peacefully at his home in London, Ontario, on Sept. 29. He was seventyseven. A longtime CAML member, Ed was founder of Hysen Music Ltd., a Londonbased national sheet music and book distributor. He also was a musician who performed locally for many years. He played oboe and English horn with the London Symphony Orchestra (now Orchestra London), and was the organist and choir director at Robinson Memorial United Church for over thirty years.
