Effective Sept. 1, 2002, Dr. S. Timothy Maloney is taking an 18-month leave of absence from his position as Director of the National Library's Music Division to become Head of the Music Library and Adjunct Professor at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis.

Christina Lockerby is on a six-week leave from her position at the Canadian National Institute for the Blind in Toronto. She will be working at the main branch of the public library (La Bibliothèque publique d'information, Centre Georges Pompidou) in Paris, France.

The National Library of Canada invites online visits to Sheet Music from Canada's Past at www.nlc-bnc.ca/sheetmusic/. This bilingual Web site is a searchable database of digitized sheet music from pre-Confederation times to the World War I era. A recent addition is the gallery of colour images of all of the sheet music covers, which highlight Canadian city and country life, fads and fashions, and work and leisure. Another 900 pieces of music were added to the database this spring, bringing the total to nearly 1,500. About 1,100 scores are available as PDF files. Copyright still applies to the majority of imprints from the time of WWI.
